



## SUMMARY SPORTING REGULATIONS IAME SERIES NETHERLANDS-NK IAME – ROOKIE 2025

- In the Sporting Regulations 2025, Rookies are defined as the first-year drivers participating in the IAME Mini Rookie class.
- In this document, we list all the provisions for you.

### CLASSES IAME MINI and IAME MINI ROOKIE

- **IAME Mini:** from 10 to 13 years old (year you turn 10 to year you turn 13).  
Where the 10-year-olds (and 9 years in the year you turn 10) have the free choice between the classes IAME Mini and IAME Mini Rookie.
- **IAME Mini Rookie:** from 7 to 10 years old (year you turn 10).  
Where the 10-year-olds (and 9 years in the year you turn 10) have the free choice between the classes IAME Mini and IAME Mini Rookie.
- If a driver, who has reached the age of 11, as a first-year IAME Mini driver submits the request to start in the IAME Mini Rookie class, the decision lies with the organization.
- The age and experience of the drivers are starting points for placing in one of the two classes.
- The IAME Mini Rookie class is considered a starter class for first-year IAME Mini drivers.
- For the IAME Mini Rookie class, if a driver participates in races during the current season that are listed on the FIA Karting Calendar 2025 or on the RGMMC Group IAME Euro Series Calendar 2025, this driver is not allowed to participate in the IAME Mini Rookie class.
- The first 5 classified drivers in the IAME Series Benelux class IAME Mini Rookie 2024 standings are obliged to participate in the IAME Mini class regardless of their age, if they want to participate in the IAME Mini or IAME Mini Rookie classes in the 2025 season. This rule can be deviated from on request, whereby the final decision is reserved to the organisation. The organization is authorized to determine whether a driver - regardless of his age - should start in the IAME Mini or IAME Mini Rookie class, based on the experience gained by this driver in one of these classes or similar classes in another competition.
