



Tyre Regulations NK IAME 2025

The competition tyres will provided by Kartstore Benelux

- For the classes, the tyres listed thereafter are prescribed by brand and type.
- Prices are per set of tyres and exclusive of VAT.
- Only tyres supplied by or on behalf of the organization will be admitted to the event, under penalty of exclusion from the event and payment to the organization of a fine in the form of the current price of a set of tyres increased by the amount of € 50.00.

- Individuals can order the tyres at their favorite NK IAME service point. The link to the list of service points on www.nkiame.nl. Otherwise, you can place orders by email to info@kartstorebenelux.com.
- Brand names, markings, code numbers, production numbers and size indications on the tyres must always remain visible.
- Any form of artificial heating, roughening, processing and/or cleaning or treating with (chemical) aids is prohibited.
- Only tyres supplied by or on behalf of the organization are allowed in the NK IAME and only normal air is allowed in the tyres, under penalty of exclusion from the competition and payment to the organization of a fine in the form of the applicable price of a set of tyres prescribed for the relevant class, increased by the amount of € 50.00.
- The organization is entitled to take tyres for examination at any time during the competition. The driver involved in the inspection will be provided with a set of tyres by the organisation for the duration of the investigation so that he can participate in the remaining races. Any costs resulting from the situation will be borne by the driver.
- New tyres may only be used from the qualification onwards.
- After the qualification, the participant has the option to replace 1 front tyre or 1 rear tyre, if the technical inspector decides after request that it is no longer desirable to drive with this tyre for safety reasons. This is due to irreparable damage, not being wear. If the technical inspector suspects incorrect use or poor mounting of the tyre, or intentional damage, the request can be refused without further explanation. No protest can be made against this decision. The unapproved tyre must first be submitted to the technical inspector for inspection before it can be replaced.

**Rules regarding the collection, fitting and storage of tyres before and after the heats.
These rules only apply to slick tyres (also not to rain tyres).**

- The race tyres can still be ordered - by participants who have not yet ordered the tyres - from the [Kartstore Benelux](#) service truck on Friday.
- The participants will receive a voucher for the racing tyres (slick and rain).
- On Saturday- and Sunday morning (see the timetable for times) the racing tyres can be picked up at the parc-ferme, handing in the tyre voucher.
- The tyres will be scanned and marked upon collection.
- The participant may take the tyres to his/her tent for assembly.
- The tyres must be used from the qualifying heat.
- The tyres will be re-scanned prior to the qualifying heat.
- After the qualifying heat, the race tyres are dismounted by the participants in the parc-ferme and are then handed over to the person in charge of the organisation in the parc-ferme.
- The tyres are kept in the parc-ferme until the next heat.
- Upon entering the parc-ferme for the next heat, the participant can obtain these tyres back in the parc-ferme. He has to mount it in the parc-ferme before the start of the next heat.
- When entering the parc-ferme, the participant may only carry tools for mounting and dismounting the tyres.
- Tyre grease/markers/water for check airtightness are present in the parc-ferme.
- Liquids and/or aerosols are not allowed in the parc-ferme.
- The tyres may not be edited.
- If the participant wants to carry out a repair or a change to the rims during the day, he must first report to the person in charge of the organization for permission for the work. He decides whether this is allowed or not. Taking into account the timetable.
- Please follow the instructions of the employees on duty in order to achieve the best possible flow.
